

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING
HELD Thursday, February 4, 2021 AT 7:30PM

Meeting was called to order by Chair, Mr. Bob Entenmann. All members were present. Also present was Fiscal Officer, Sara Hammett, Dave Compton and Andy Romoser. Mr. Jack Butler made a motion to waive the reading of the minutes, to pay the bills presented and to approve purchase orders. Mr. David Yoder seconded the motion and the motion carried with a roll call vote of all ayes. A payment listing of bills presented are attached hereto and made apart hereof. A Bank Reconciliation and Bank Statement for December 2020 and January 2021 were presented for approval. A copy of the Cash Summary by Fund is attached hereto and made apart hereof.

Resident Dan Kilbor, 1512 Washington North Road was present and discussed the situation of his son parking his semi on Sauder Drive. Trustees mentioned the resolution to limit vehicle parking on Lucas Drive, Will Drive and Sauder Drive and that it has been tabled.

Fire Department Chief Dave Compton mentioned that the new squad was supposed to be picked up last week but wasn't ready, but will be ready for pick-up February 4th. Collin McBride will be going to Paramedic school at Grant Hospital. Mr. Jack Butler made a motion to approve the agreement for payment of training expenses for Collin McBride's Paramedic School. Mr. David Yoder seconded the motion and the motion carried with a roll call vote of all ayes.

Road Department Superintendent Andy Romoser purchased three sets of carharts. AEP will be closing Middle Bellville Road February 22 to 26 from 7am to 5pm. Received phone calls about the ally, addresses 400 to 444, off of Garver Road, about not plowing the ally. Discussion was had and the Township is not legally allowed to plow the ally and will let the residents know. Bid openings for the 422 Chip and Seal 2021 will be held February 18th. Bids are due by 6:45pm and will be open at 7pm. Estimated price for 17.2 miles is \$290,847.39, this doesn't include the agreement with Madison. Andy Romoser requested to hire someone to test the emulsion on the roads that were tar and chipped last year 2020. Received a call from Bill Halter at 4034 Norris Road with driveway issues with water running across the front of the driveway then down into the ditch. Discussed the driveway permit package and will revise and have legal counsel approve.

Mr. Jack Butler called legal counsel about the right-of-way at Belmar and State Route 42 and is waiting for a call back.

Mr. Bob Entenmann received a call from a resident on Georgia Lane about someone surveying the field. Resident at 1871 White Pine called about the snow plow going off the road and a car being parked on the road. Mr. Entenmann will talk with the resident and ask them to park in the driveway. Discussed the archeological study and is waiting on two more firms for a quote and there is no issue with the farmer plowing the property on Vanderbilt Road.

There being no further business, Mr. Jack Butler made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. David Yoder seconded the motion and the motion carried with the meeting ending at 8:30pm.
