

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING  
HELD Thursday, June 3, 2021 AT 7:30PM

Meeting was called to order by Chair, Mr. Bob Entenmann. All members were present. Also present was Fiscal Officer, Sara Hammett, Andy Romoser and Tim Boggs. Mr. Jack Butler made a motion to waive the reading of the minutes, to pay the bills presented and to approve purchase orders. Mr. David Yoder seconded the motion and the motion carried with a roll call vote of all ayes. A payment listing of bills presented are attached hereto and made apart hereof.

Zoning Inspector, Tim Boggs presented Resolution #21-21 for 2887 Stafford Drive for being a grass nuisance. Mr. Jack Butler moved for the adoption of the Resolution. Mr. David Yoder seconded the motion and the motion carried with a roll call vote of all ayes. A copy of the resolution is attached hereto and made apart hereof. On June 10<sup>th</sup> at 7pm a Zoning Board of Appeals hearing will be held for Chris May at 981 Vanderbilt Road and Andrew Dill at 788 W Alexander Road for both wanting to build bigger buildings on their properties. Presented picture of Mr. Tate's property, discussed property with Trustees and will further discuss with Legal Counsel. Wrote permits.

Road Department Superintendent, Andy Romoser received the 1<sup>st</sup> driveway culvert application and was approved and done. Received a call from Colleen Shaughe at 667 Morrison about water in the driveway and Road Department will handle. Would like to put crushed concrete on GovDeals. Mrs. Akers on Touby Road asked about hidden driveway signs, which are no longer put up. Changed the culvert out on Scott Road and are continuing to mow. Discussed and signed the contract with Kokosing for the Deerfield, King, Gatton Drive paving project. For the Fire Department the new squad has tire damage. They also received a grant from TC Energy for \$5,000 for MARCS Radios.

Fiscal Officer, Sara Hammett discussed Direct Deposit. Mr. David Yoder made a motion to approve to start Direct Deposit for pay on July 14, 2021. Mr. Jack Butler seconded the motion and motion carried with a roll call vote of ayes. Discussed Fire Department pay frequency.

The budget hearing is scheduled for July 1 at 7:15pm.

Mr. Jack Butler made a motion to move into executive session to discuss Washington Township Property for reasoning of sale of Township Property. Mr. David Yoder seconded the motion and the motion carried with a roll call vote of all ayes. Mr. Jack Butler made a motion to move back into Regular Session. Mr. David Yoder seconded the motion and the motion carried with a roll call vote of all ayes.

Mr. Bob Entenmann received a call from Joe Weithman with Mull & Weithman Architects, Inc. and will try to get the PARS to USDA by the end of the quarter. Saved \$135,000 on the site plan, discussed the sewer, soft costs and new building site property.

There being no further business, Mr. Jack Butler made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Bob Entenmann seconded the motion and the motion carried.
