Mr. Bob Entenmann seconded the motion and the motion carried with a roll call vote of all ayes. Mr. Jack Butler made a motion to move back into Regular Session. Mr. David Yoder seconded the motion and the motion carried with a roll call vote of all ayes.

There being no further business, Mr. Jack Butler made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Bob Entenmann seconded the motion and the motion carried with the meeting ending at 9:35pm.
