

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING
HELD Thursday, November 18, 2021 7:32 pm

Meeting was called to order by Chair, Mr. Bob Entenmann. All members were present. Also present was Fiscal Officer, Annette Depue, Scott Penhorwood, with the Road Department, and resident, Ryan Ryder. Mr. Jack Butler made a motion to waive the reading of the minutes and to pay the bills presented. Mr. David Yoder seconded the motion and the motion carried with a roll call vote of all ayes. A payment listing of bills presented are attached hereto and made apart hereof.

Resident Ryan Ryder lives on Middle-Bellville Road where internet service is not available. He was inquiring on available funding to assist in service being available in that area. Bob Entenmann will be investigating to see if it is feasible.

Road Department Scott Penhorwood reported that the truck is fixed and to be picked up next week. Mr. Jack Butler will go with the Road Department to inspect the repairs. It was also determined that due to the break-in at 2490 Possum Run Road, the doors and windows will not be replaced, but will be boarded for security. Dave Yoder inquired on leaf pick-up, Scott Penhorwood reported that the majority have been collected. Zach Glass will be going for CDL test next week.

Mr. Bob Entenmann spoke with Rob Earhart in regards to the appraisal of 2490 Possum Run Road to determine what is the best approach and most beneficial for the township.

In the absence of Tim Boggs, Mr. Bob Entenmann read the zoning report. A permit was issued for a 30x40 barn, a new address was added at 1409 Kings Corners E. Road, and they are still working on resolving the issue with the condemned house at 1134 W. Hanley Road. 1980 South Main Road was declined a second drive because of proximity to property line. Resident complained of free- range chickens. There have been several calls taken and handled in regards to property lines, sheds, etc.

Annette Depue, Fiscal Officer presented Purchase Order for BWC and trustees signed.

In the absence of Fire Chief, Dave Compton, Bob Entenmann presented & explained the vaccine mandate from Ohio Health. The donation of medical supplies will offset the decrease in their medical contribution.

Mr. Jack Butler reported that on 11/09/2021, the boring was completed at the new firehouse location and the "For Lease" Visconsi sign has been posted.

Dave Yoder presented a need to implement a compensation plan for Fiscal Officer consulting.

Trustees are continuing to research the available advantages of the American Rescue Plan funds.

Mr. Jack Butler made a motion to move forward with Huntington Bank for financing of the new firehouse due to delay of USDA loan. Mr. Dave Yoder seconded the motion and the motion carried with a roll call vote of all ayes.

There being no further business, Mr. Jack Butler made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Dave Yoder seconded the motion and the motion carried with the meeting ending at 8:35pm.
