

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING  
HELD Thursday, February 16, 2023 7:30pm

Meeting was called to order by Chair, Mr. Dave Yoder. All members were present. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Annette Depue, Road Superintendent, Andy Romoser, and Zoning Inspector, Mr. Tim Boggs. Mr. Bob Entenmann made a motion to waive the reading of the minutes and to pay the bills, approve Purchase Orders, & approve reallocations as presented. Mr. Jack Butler seconded the motion and the motion carried with a roll call vote of all ayes.

Mr. Tim Boggs, Zoning Inspector, reported that 2661 Lexington Avenue requested a permit for an addition. Wes New on Lexington Avenue did get his property surveyed and now he will be proposing for rezoning for business. The petition will be filed on Monday and the hearing will be on Thursday. He also reported that he received the building plans for the house that is being built on the existing foundation at 1134 Hanley Road.

Superintendent, Andy Romoser reported that 3 bids were submitted for the paving project on February 16, 2023 before 6:45 pm. All bids were opened at 7:00 pm that same evening. They were submitted by Shelly & Sands at \$238,813.40, Kokosing at \$231,613.06, and Sarver Asphalt at \$227,649.60. Mr. Romoser also reported that truck repair is finished and that the cost came in lower than expected, however, Truck #1 now needs repairs that are estimated at \$4,000. Mr. Romoser has temporarily repaired it.

Fiscal Officer, Annette Depue, presented the Permanent Appropriation Budget. Mr. Bob Entenmann made a motion to accept and pass Resolution #2-23, Mr. Jack Butler seconded the motion and the motion carried with a roll call vote of all ayes. Mrs. Depue also shared the information with the Trustees in regards to the Annual Meeting with County Engineer on 3/27/2023 – all plan to attend. A current cash summary by fund report was distributed to the Trustees.

Mr. Jack Butler reported that the culvert on Pulver Road will start next week and that Kokosing will be bringing more millings for the New Fire Station/Building project at the end of March.

Mr. Bob Entenmann is still working on a new aggregate contract.

After no further business, Mr Jack Butler made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Dave Yoder seconded the motion and the motion carried with the meeting ending at 8:41 pm.
